Dear Sir/Madam

With reference to your application dated 01.06.2008 and subsequent correspondence with the school / inspection in this regard, I am directed to convey the grant for Provisional approval of the Competent Authority of the Board for Middle Classes syllabus for a period of three years w.e.f 01.04.2009 to 31.03.2012.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

- "The School will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the middle classes."
- 2. The grant for approval of the middle classes is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation on the part of the Board to affiliate the Secondary Classes (IX-X).
- 3. The approval will also be subject to the condition that the school will make a fresh application for Provisional Affiliation of the Secondary Classes (IX-X) to the Board on line through CBSE website www.cbse.nic.in in accordance with the rules and condition for Provisional Affiliation when classes VIII has been started.
- 4. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII:

- (d) School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be restricted as per the actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number mentioned at (a) (b) and (c) above.
- (e) Schools running on less than 01 acre campus shall restrict number of students as follows -

The school shall appoint only qualified and eligible staff as per qualification laid down
in the rules.

- 6. Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.
- 7. Service conditions pay and allowance and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be in no way less than that of corresponding employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.
- 8. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
- 9. The rate of tuition fee and other fees charged should be commensurate with the facilities provided.
- 10. The admission to the school shall be opened to all without any discrimination on the ground of religion, cast or race, place of birth or any of them.
- 11. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
- 12. The school will abide itself by the rules and conditions for affiliation as given in the Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
- 13. The school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'persons with disabilities act-1995'.
- 14. The school should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers or computer student ratio of 1:20 and proper software alongwith facility of Broad Band Connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on from any service provider.
- 15. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the Board every year.
- 16. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is 1130181. This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the Board.
- 17. Reserve Fund be maintained in the joint name of the Secretary, CBSE and the School Authorities in accordance with the enrolment in the school from time to time.
- 18. Renewal of Registration of Society if any, be ensured.
- 19. School will provide physical facilities as per norms of the Board. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under:-

With reference to your application dated 29/06/2011 and subsequent inspection of the school, I am directed to convey sanction for provisional affiliation to the above said school for Senior School Certificate Examination for a period of three years w.e.f. 01.04.2012 to 31.03.2015 in the following subjects:-

(a) Languages: - ENGLISH (CORE)

(b) Elective Subjects: - ECONOMICS, MATHEMATICS, PHYSICS, CHEMISTRY, BIOLOGY, PAINTING, PHYSICAL EDUCATION, BUSINESS STUDIES, ACCOUNTANCY, INFORMATICS PRACTICES, COMPUTER SCIENCE

The sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions in addition to the general conditions intimated at the time of grant of provisional affiliation for secondary classes:

 "The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Senior School Certificate Examination and changes made therein from time to time."

2. The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the

Board upto Classes X.

3. As per the newly implemented CCE scheme vide Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009, the students of class X will appear in the Summative Assessment-II (SA-II) conducted at the school level only. However, those students of class X, who opt to move out of CBSE system in Class XI to any other Board, will exercise the option to appear in the SA-II conducted at the Board level. Both the students will get the same certificate issued by the Board at the end of class X.

4. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State

Govt./UT.

- 5. The school will provide additional suitable facilities for classes XI and XII, as per requirements laid down in the rules.
- 6. It will increase the number of books in the Library and equipments in the Laboratories/Workshops with adequate games facilities etc. in consonance with the requirements of the Board for Classes XI & XII.
- 7. It will appoint only qualified staff to teach Classes XI & XII as per requirements laid down by the Board.
- 8. It will provide facilities for adequate co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for the wholesome development of the students.
- 9. It will abide itself by the Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board and other rules and regulations prescribed by the Board from time to time.

10. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the

riliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII:-

 The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc.

13. The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation on the prescribed form together with the prescribed fee of Rs. 25,000/- and other essential documents in the preceding year before the expiry of the date.

14. The school will open CBSE pattern classes XI w.e.f. 1.4.2012. Accordingly, 1st Batch of class XII of the school will be appearing at the CBSE Examination to be held in 2014.

15. Other conditions are as per Annexure 'A' enclosed.

16. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-

a) The school is required to appoint PGTs in the concerned subjects.

b) There are some part-time teachers whereas school is required to appoint only qualified teachers in the prescribed grades of pay on regular basis, as per Affiliation Bye-laws of the Board.

c) The school is required to equip the Science lab with more instruments.

d) The School Managing Committee is required to be reconstituted having each of 02 parents representative, teacher representatives and 02 Principals of affiliated schools preferably of Kendriya Vidyalaya/Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya.

e) The school is required to procure more books relevant to the academic level of students in the library.

f) The school is required to provide separate reading room for students / teachers.

- g) A documentary proof regarding implementation and regular deduction of EPF is required to be submitted alongwith latest Pay Bill and Bank Challan.
- As per details of enrollment of students of the school, optimum limit is not maintained in all classes.
 Hence section-wise enrollment of students may be restricted with optimum number of 40 students per section.
- The school is required to submit the balance sheet for the last three years which is in the name of school
 itself duly audited by the Authorized Chartered Accountant.
